

Bruce Bender Meets Death in Solomons

Bruce Bender, 27, former Lincoln high school athlete, has been killed in action, according to word received Tuesday morning by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. W. Bender, now of Manitowoc. Time and place of his death were not given in the telegram. However, he was serving with a U. S. navy hospital unit and is known to have been in the Solomons.

Bruce graduated from Lincoln high school in 1932, where he was a member of the football and boxing teams. During the following three years he was employed by the Prentiss Wabers Products company, later going to Los Angeles, Calif., where he worked in a drug store. Experience gained there resulted in his assignment to the hospital unit after joining the navy.

Besides his parents he leaves three brothers, Charles and Richard of Los Angeles and Merle of Manitowoc and one sister, Mrs. Myles Terry of Lewiston, Ill. Local relatives include an aunt, Mrs. George A. Otto, and two uncles, Leonard and Francis Bender. Bruce was born in Wisconsin Rapids on March 1, 1915.
