

Body of Cpl. Rickl Returned from Korea

The body of Cpl. Clarence E. Rickl, 25, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Rickl, Route 2, Milladore, is being returned for burial in his home community, the department of defense announced today.

Bodies of 615 Americans who lost their lives as a result of fighting in Korea were aboard the Allegheny Victory which arrived at San Francisco on Sunday.

Cpl. Rickl was killed in action with the 38th regiment, 2nd Infantry division, on July 31. He had been in Korea since last March.

Memorial services were held September 15 at St. Kilian's Catholic church in Blenker.
