**Pfc. Paul Risley Is Seriously Wounded**

Pfc. Paul Risley, 20, was seriously wounded in action in Belgium on October 26, according to word received here by his grandmother, Mrs. Clara Odell, 840 Sixth street south.

Private First Class Risley entered the service about 15 months ago and had been overseas since August of this year, serving with the infantry. He formerly lived in this city, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Stewart Risley moving to Libby, Mont., about seven years ago.

He said he was wounded in the back of the head while in the front lines. He is still in the hospital and is recovering from his wounds. He is expected to be discharged in a few days.
