Two Recently Married Men Among Crash Victims

QUONSET POINT, R. I. (UP)— Eight Navy fliers, killed in a bomber crash at sea Thursday, included two men who had been married less than two months.

The victims of the crash included Aviation Mechanic John R. Quirk, 27, Lavella, Pa., who was married Nov. 8, and Aviation Ordnance Man George A. Buehler, 22, Nekoosa, Wis, who was married Oct. 4.

Other victims included: Lt. Comdr. Nobel R. Kean, 34, Appon-Ill., and Electronics Technician Roland O. Eades, 29, Indianapolis, Ind.

The men were on a night mission in a Neptune bomber when their plane crashed at sea 75 miles southeast of Block Island.
