Dr. Louis Leakey was born to the earliest man we are his missionary parents in Kenya an elder of the Kikuyus PRINTED PATTERN spat in his face. And the ritual made the infant, whose later discoveries were to push back the history of man hundreds of thousands of years, a member of the African tribe.

This is one of the intriguing facts about the burly, greyhaired paleontologist (bone scientist) scattered through a forthcoming National Geographic special. "Dr. Leakey and the Dawn of Man" which CBS-TV will broadcast in color in

the new season. When the hour-long program is over viewers may conclude for themselves whether Dr. Leakey has already found "the missing link"—a phrase he detests —in his effort to complete the sequence of our ancestors from mindless brute


to thinking man. Recently executive producer Robert C. Doyle said the National Geographic felt many people were as interested in finding out where the race came from as they were in going into space. The ratings will tell whether this judgment is correct —at least as far as television audiences go -but there is certainly a fascinating tale to tell. It poses questions scientists

have been debating for decades: Where and when did our ancestors originate? Leakey agrees with Darwin that it was somewhere in Africa, and 15 years ago he found what may have been the actual place. Sometime in prehistory a volcanic eruption laid thick deposits of ash and lava over an area around the Ngorogoro crater almost the end of the Rift Valley in Kenya. Then a river, as the eons passed, carved a chasm through it known as Oludavi


