Dear Dwendolyn: I almost never recommend books but I'm going to make an exception because I've just read a book that could help save your life. It is called "The Prison of My Mind," by Barbara Field Benziger. The publisher is Walker. If your bookstore doesn't have it, ask them to get it.

This book is a moving personal account of a courageous woman who conquered mental illness. Her honesty and openness will give encouragement and hope to every person who fears he is cracking up.

The best answer for one who is suicidal is a therapist in whom he has confidence. The author of "Prison of My Mind" emphasizes this point. While Mrs. Benziger credits therapy with saving her life she makes it abundantly clear that not all psychiatrists are humane, kind and competent.


