

### LIEUT JOHN BUCKLEY KILLED

Word was received last week to the effect that John Buckley had been killed in France in an airplane accident. There were no particulars of the affair, but it was known that Mr. Buckley was an instructor in the aerial corps, and had been in France for some time past engaged in this work. The date given of the accident was November 8th. As there are six John Buckleys in the service it was hoped at first that there might be some mistake in the matter, but later advices confirm the report that it was our John Buckley from here. Deceased was born in Grand Rapids and was 25 years old, and has lived here at different times and was well known here. He was one of the first to go into the service when his country called for men, and going into the aero service he soon became proficient in the work and was elevated to instructor. He is survived by his mother, Mrs. Georgina Buckley, and two sisters, Mrs. Fred Ragan and Miss Clarissa Buckley, the latter of Cedar Rapids, Iowa. John had many friends here who will extend their heartfelt sympathy to the sorrowing relatives in their affliction.
