Marshfield to Honor Its First War Dead

Marshfield, Wis.—Memorial services will be held in the Emmanuel Lutheran church here Sunday at 2 p. m. for Private Ivan Sadowska, 22, who was the first Marshfield man to be killed in action in World War 2.

Private Sadowska, who was reportedly missing since November 8, 1942, when he participated in the landings on North Africa, was officially reported killed in action in a recent letter received from the war department by the soldier's parents, Mr. and Mrs. Gus Sadowska.

Private Sadowska's father was formerly sheriff of Wood county, and the family is widely known in Wisconsin Rapids.
