Memorial Rites For Two Cousins Sunday

A memorial service will be held at 2:30 Sunday afternoon at the First Congregational church for Gordon Earl Galloway, aviation machinist's mate, 2/c, and Julius Rude, fireman, 2/c. The two young men were cousins.

Gordon, son of Mrs. Cora Galloway, 1253 Washington avenue, had been missing in action with the United States navy in the Pacific theater since October 25, 1944, and was recently declared officially dead by the navy department.

His cousin, Julius, son of the late Julius A. Rude of Route 1, and Mrs. Flora Franson Rude, died on February 18, 1942, when his ship, the U. S. S. Truxtun, was lost on convoy duty off the coast of Newfoundland.

Julius Rude's immediate family is living at present in Tucson, Ariz.
