Pittsville Soldier Is Badly Wounded in North Africa

Pittsville, Wis.—Sgt. Thomas J. Redmond, 26, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Redmond, who reside four miles north of Pittsville, was seriously wounded in action in the North African theater of war May 14. His parents were notified of this by a telegram received Thursday night from the war department.

Sgt. Redmond enlisted February 19, 1941, completed his training in Virginia, and was ordered abroad last October. He served with the army engineering corps in North Africa.

The message from the war department did not disclose the nature of Sgt. Redmond's wounds, but the parents anticipate further details by mail.
