The Rev. John Corcoran of Victory Christian Church called Calloway's death "tragic, unexpected, senseless."

Calloway never let things get him down and he was very close to his family, the minister told mourners.

When the soldier's father suffered a heart attack in January, Calloway went AWOL — absent without leave — from his unit in Texas to be by his dad, the minister said. "It showed where his priorities were, to be next to his family."
