**CRASHES IN OCEAN** — Ensign Frank H. Stuve, 23, who was killed October 20 when his plane crashed into the ocean off the coast of Oregon, was the son of Mr. and Mrs. H. A. Stuve of Owen and nephew of Mr. and Mrs. L. N. Rezin of Cranmoor. Ensign Stuve enlisted in the naval air corps in May, 1942, from Cranmoor, where he had lived for several years, and began training at Sioux City, Iowa. At the time of his death, he was stationed at Astoria, Oregon, where his wife had come to live with him. A memorial service will be held Sunday at 1:30 p.m. in Humbird, Wis., his boyhood home.
