## JOSEPH WHITE IS LISTED MISSING

Pvt. Joseph J. White, 24, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ulysses White, Cran-  
mour, has been reported missing in  
action in northern France, accord-  
ing to a war department telegram  
received by the parents. He had  
last been heard from 10 days ago.

Private White, a Winnebago In-  
dian, was born in Greenwood, Clark  
county. He was graduated from  
Lincoln high school here with the  
class of 1939.

He entered the armed forces in  
1942 and was a member of the in-  
fantry. He is the only son in the  
family and has one sister, Irene.  
The father is employed by the Ne-  
lson-Lidwards Paper company.
