

Former Bishop Pike lost near Dead Sea

JERUSALEM (AP) — Mrs. Pike was under a doctor's care at their hotel room in Jerusalem.

In Santa Barbara, Calif. Pike's mother Mrs. Pearl Chambers said her son and daughter-in-law went to the Holy Land to study the origins of Christianity and the Dead Sea Scrolls for a book he was writing. Pike told friends that he hoped to find documents or ancient records that would provide more information on Christ.

Pike was brought up in the Roman Catholic faith but he came in agnostic during his college days. He took law degrees from the University of California and Yale and then worked for the Securities and Exchange Commission in Washington and taught at George Washington University.

He joined the Episcopal Church during World War II when he was a U.S. naval officer. After the war he was ordained from Union Theological Seminary and served as a rector and teacher until 1952 when he was appointed dean of the Cathedral of St. John the Divine in New York.

Pike was elected bishop coadjutor of San Francisco in 1958. His views on religion became increasingly controversial within a few years and drew criticism and charges of heresy from more conservative members of the Episcopal Church. He challenged the belief in the virgin birth of Christ questioned literal interpretations of the Bible and was opposed to the Vietnam war.

He resigned his bishopric in 1966 and became a research fellow at the Center for the Study of Democratic Institutions in Santa Barbara. His position was later terminated in a reorganization.

WTMJ chief announcer Gordon Thomas dies

MILWAUKEE (AP) — Gordon Thomas, 52, long time chief announcer at radio station WTMJ died at his home early today.

Thomas who joined the station in 1940 and took over a morning talk show in 1942 had been released from a hospital two weeks ago after recovering from a heart attack and complications from surgery.

Funeral services were pending for Thomas whose sarcasm was entertained and sometimes irritated listeners for 20 years on the talk show.
