"Here it is," I said, softly. "Stop that sniffing and get out of here. We don't allow boys to cry in this clubhouse..."

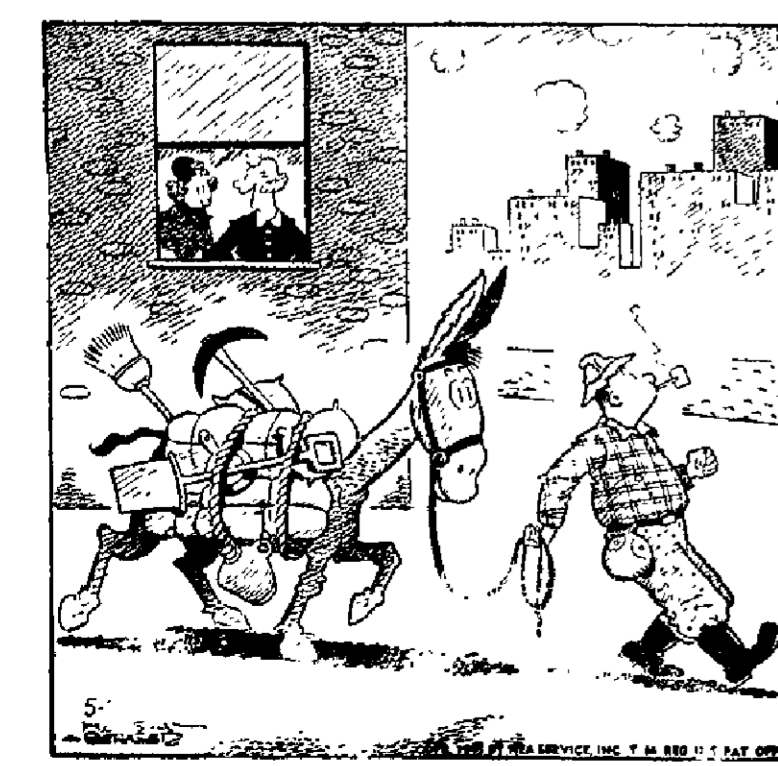
"Oi! I thank you, Hawkins!" he cried. "Dot iss all now. I haff no more words to say. Goodbye, now. I see you sometime yet!"

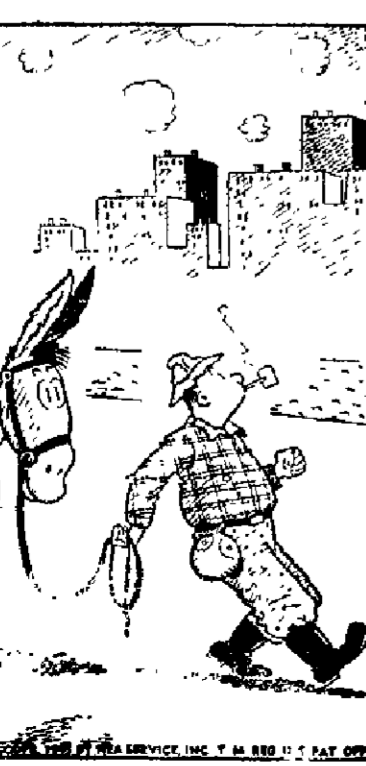
